Crazy Modern Quilt Class



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Class Description

Learn a modern method to create crazy quilt blocks, building on foundation piecing and specialty sewing machine stitches.

Project

Crazy Modern is a fresh interpretation of the crazy quilts of the early 1900's. Learn the basics of foundation piecing, use up your scraps, and expand your stitch repertoire with decorative stitches on your sewing machine.

Duration

Half day workshop.

Skills covered in class

- Foundation piecing on muslin.
- Color theory using scrap fabrics.
- Using a variety of stitches on sewing machine.
- Exploring decorative sewing machine stitches using a variety of thread types and weights.

Supply list

Materials:

- 41 5" squares
- 3½ yd muslin for foundation piecing.
- 2 yd for borders
- 4½ yd backing
- 3 yd of a variety of scraps and strings that coordinate with the 5" squares
- Variety of threads

Stitch tip: Gather strips and scraps in colors that coordinate with the charm pack, but don't worry about matching exactly. You are creating a color controlled scrappy quilt!

Notions:

- Standard quilting and sewing notions
- Sewing machine with variety of stitches
- Pencil
- 12½" ruler
