Class Description

This class will teach two quilt blocks and the basics of machine applique.

Project

This two-block wallhanging is the perfect project to use your favorite scraps and show your love of sewing. The center appliqué is a cinch with fusible webbing. Finished size: 30 x 30".

Duration

Full day workshop

Skills covered in class

- Basic cutting and piecing for blocks
- Fusible applique pieces from a pattern
- Machine appliqué using straight stitch, satin stitch, buttonhole stitch and other decorative stitches
- Couching yarn



Supply list

Materials for class:

- 1 yd neutral fabric for appliqué and block backgrounds
- 3 warm fat quarters, or equivalent scraps (red/orange/yellow)
- 3 cool fat quarters, or equivalent scraps (blue/green/purple)
- Additional fabric for appliqué:
 - 2 x 8" scrap gray solid for needle
 - 1 fat eighth brown tonal or solid for spools
 - 1 fat quarter black for letters
 - 1 yd yarn for thread

Notions:

- Standard quilting and sewing notions, including sewing machine capable of blanket or zig-zag stitch
- 3/4 yd Paper-backed Fusible Web ([Wonder-Under®](#) or [Soft Fuse](#))
- [Appliqué pressing sheet](#) or parchment paper
- 3 x 9" piece of medium weight cut-away embroidery stabilizer
- Temporary adhesive spray such as 505 brand
- Washable liquid white school glue, like Elmer's brand
- Bamboo skewer, optional, but recommended
