


USE SOCIAL SHOP PROGRAMS TO BUILD COMMUNITY AND DRIVE SALES

- 2. Provide space for this activity or presenter






Free Motion Quilting Club

- New monthly free motion quilting design

- 3. Suggestions for upselling notions and accessories at meetings



Stripper's Club



- Host a monthly meeting featuring a new pattern and create your own themed kit each month with new fabric lines or curated sets.
- You Spin Me Right Round is perfect for this club!
- SALES: Club fees, pattern sales, fabric and any tools/notions to make the projects.



Ruler Club



- Feature a new ruler and related project each month.
- Diamonds are Forever uses the Diamond Reqs ruler from Studio180, and shows how to improv design with traditional piecing accuracy.
- SALES: Club fees, pattern sales, fabric and any tools/notions to make the projects.





Applique Club



- Get Spooled is a great basic fusible applique club project as a wallhanging in your sewing room.
- SALES: Club fees, pattern sales, fabric and any tools/notions to make the projects.

Filmore is a great blend of traditional and modern piecing techniques with upsell suggestions for each block, and three layouts.




Quilt Lit 101 Block of the Month

What better way to celebrate No Housework Day than to sew a NOPE quilt?







Star Wars Day (May 4)
